With more than 24 million media articles from various Swiss sources and up to 6,000 new articles every day from the German and French-speaking regions of Switzerland, Swissdox@LiRI offers a unique insight into the debates in our country – from the "Schweizer Illustrierte" 1911 to *lematin.ch* today.

Swissdox@LiRI is designed for big data analyses. The platform allows for keyword search queries and returns, as output, every article in full text which contains the searched (partial) terms. The data can then be downloaded and further processed and analyzed, enabling the handling of a broad spectrum of interdisciplinary as well as discipline-specific research questions.
